DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO BATH BUILDING

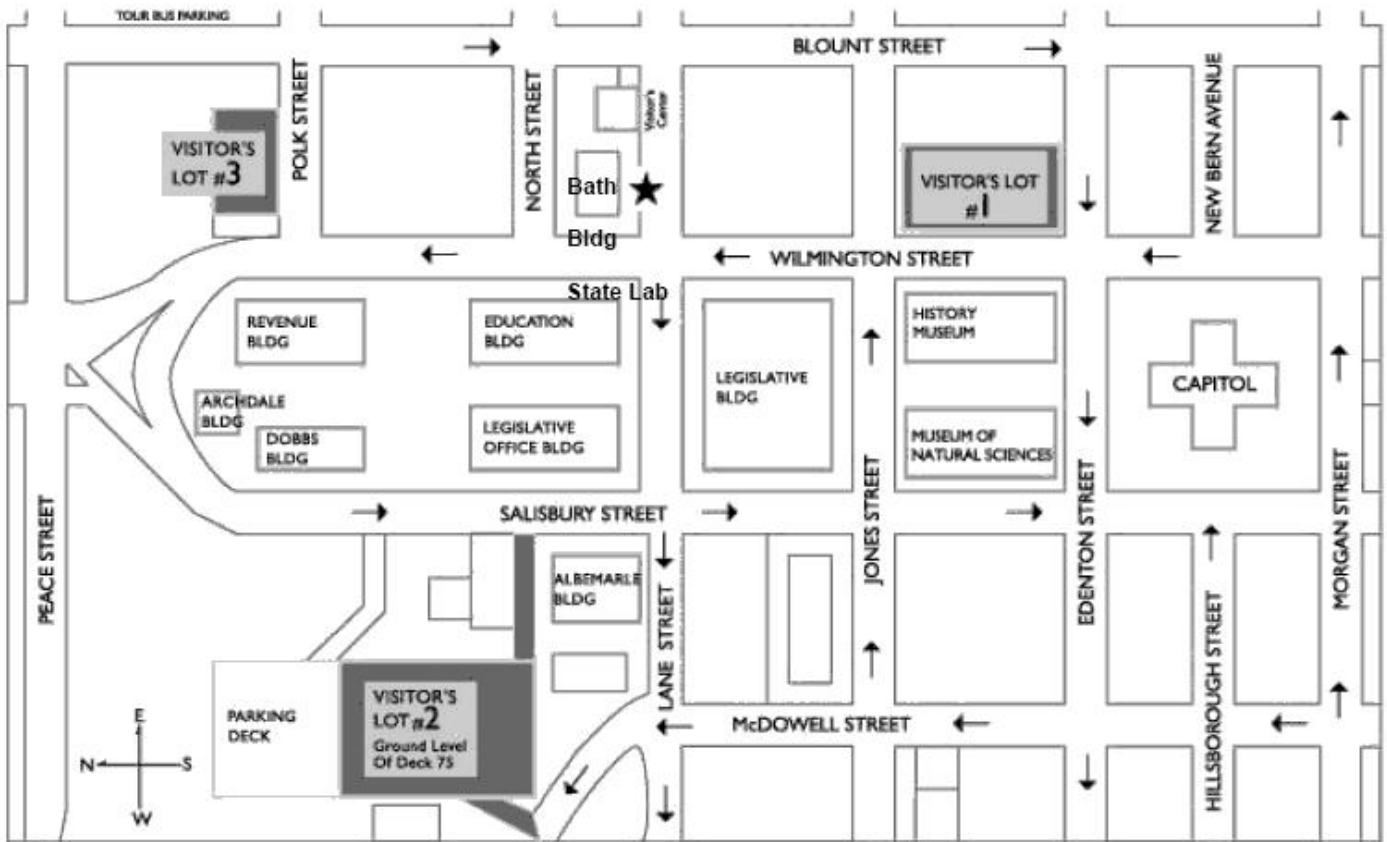
From the North or East:

Take the Capital Boulevard exit off I-440 north of Raleigh. Follow the Capital Boulevard (Downtown) designation. Continue south approximately two miles and turn left onto Jones Street. Turn left on Jones Street and follow to Wilmington Street. Make a left turn on Wilmington Street and continue two blocks. The Bath Building is on the right.

From the West or South:

From I-40 / I-440 E, take Exit 298 B, South Saunders Street. Keep right and continue to McDowell Street. Follow McDowell Street in the direction of downtown. Turn right on Morgan Street and follow to Wilmington Street and make a left turn. Follow Wilmington Street four blocks. The Bath Building is on the right.
