**Re:** Transition to Online COVID-19 Test Orders and Results

The North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) will stop mailing hardcopy COVID-19 results reports to submitters on October 17, 2021. **Starting Monday, October 18, 2021**, COVID-19 results reports will only be available online through the NCSLPH <u>Electronic Test Orders and Results (ETOR)</u> and <u>Clinical and Environmental Lab Results (CELR)</u> systems. All other NCSLPH test results reports are also available through CELR, but will still be mailed to the submitting facility.

In addition to the reporting changes, NCSLPH is transitioning away from paper COVID-19 test order forms. **Starting Monday, November 1, 2021,** COVID-19 test orders for specimens submitted to NCSLPH should be placed online in the <u>ETOR</u> system. ETOR expedites COVID-19 testing; provides the real-time status of every specimen submitted from the facility; remembers patient, facility, and provider information for faster test ordering; and can send notifications when new results are available.

To join ETOR, a member of the submitting facility staff must fill out this <u>online form</u>. At least one individual at a facility must be trained in using ETOR, before new user accounts for that facility will be approved.
