**Re:** Pediatric HCV Testing

Effective immediately, the North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) will begin sending clinical specimens from pediatric patients (2 to <18 years of age) that require Hepatitis C Virus (HCV) testing to LabCorp. LabCorp results will be attached to NCSLPH reports in the NCSLPH Clinical and Environmental Lab Results (CELR) online portal and included in paper results sent via the State courier. Testing for HCV on patients less than 2 years of age is not available through NCSLPH.

This change is temporary and part of a quality improvement initiative at NCSLPH. Submitters should continue submitting these specimens to NCSLPH with the <u>HIV/HCV Testing Report Form, DHHS 1111</u>. This change should not impact in turn-around-times or affect other testing at NCSLPH.
