**Re:** Courier Schedules and Sample/Specimen Transport – Winter Holidays, 2023

The North Carolina State Laboratory of Public Health (NCSLPH) DOA Medical Courier <u>will not operate</u> December 25, 26, and 27, 2023, or January 1, 2024. <u>UPS</u> and <u>FedEx</u> <u>will be closed</u> on Monday, December 25, 2023 and Monday, January 1, 2024. <u>UPS</u> and FedEx <u>will operate normally</u> on December 26 and 27, 2023.

## DOA Medical Courier:

- 1. Will deliver specimens picked up on Friday, December 22 to NCSLPH by Saturday, December 23.
- 2. Will not pick up specimens on December 25, 26, or 27, 2023.
- 3. Will resume normal pick-up schedule on Thursday, December 28, 2023.
  - a. Specimens collected after the DOA courier arrives on Friday, December 22, 2023 should be stored at the appropriate temperature according to the <a href="NCSLPH Specimen Storage">NCSLPH Specimen Storage</a> and Shipping Guide until pick up on December 28.
- 4. Will deliver specimens picked up on Friday, December 29 to NCSLPH by Saturday, December 30.
- 5. Will not pick up specimens on Monday, January 1, 2024.
- 6. Will resume normal operations on Tuesday, January 2, 2024.

## FedEx/UPS:

1. Specimens sent on Friday, December 22, 2023, should be scheduled for delivery on Saturday, December 23, 2023.

The NCSLPH will be closed for testing on December 25-27, 2023, and January 1, 2024, but will be accepting specimens. Submitters should be aware that results from specimens collected on December 22 and December 29 will be delayed and patient management impacts should be considered.

Please remember, to notify DOA Medical Courier and SLPH if you are submitting frozen specimens for pickup on Thursday, December 28, 2023, or Tuesday, January 2, 2024, via email to slph.courier@dhhs.nc.gov.

Submitters must ensure that specimens and samples are stored using the proper conditions until the above couriers resume normal operations. Improperly stored or transported specimens may be rejected for testing. NCSLPH will request recollection of specimens if needed for testing. Please refer to NCSLPH <u>SCOPE Appendix A</u> or the <u>NCSLPH Specimen Storage and Shipping Guide</u> for detailed specimen storage requirements.
